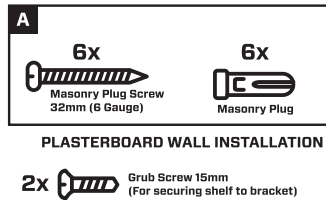
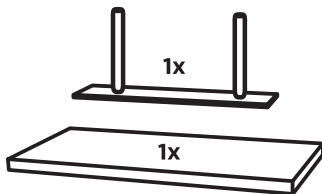
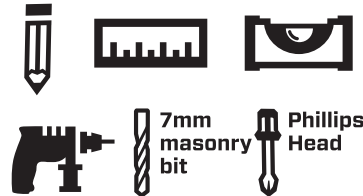


FLOATING SHELF INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

HARDWARE SUPPLIED



TOOLS REQUIRED



CAPACITY

Weight load capacity can vary based on the type of wall you're affixing the shelf to. As a guideline please see below:



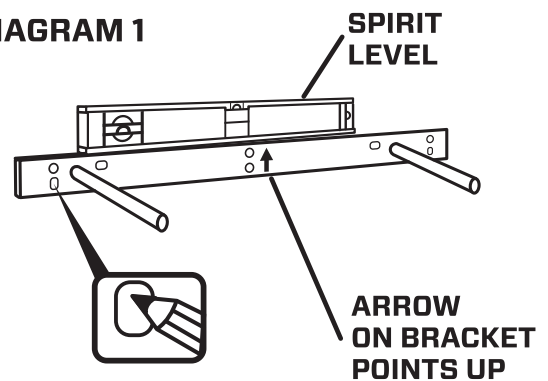

PLEASE READ THROUGH THE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS.

STEP 1

Before beginning, review the Fixing Hints. Position the bracket at your desired height against the wall. Using a pencil, mark the positions of the six holes. Ensure the arrow on the bracket points upward. Use a spirit level to check that the bracket is level (refer to Diagram 1).

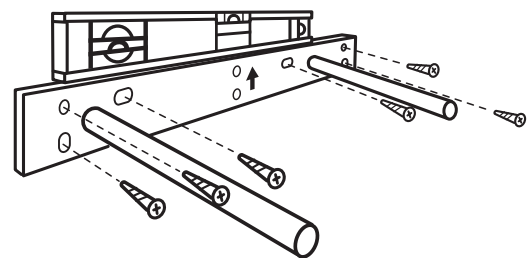

STEP 2 (for Masonry walls)

Using a 7mm masonry drill bit, drill a hole 40mm deep. Gently tap a wall plug into the hole until it is flush with the wall surface. Position the bracket over the installed plug and secure it with the masonry plug screw. For additional installation details, refer to the Fixing Hints. We recommend pre-drilling a small pilot hole for easier

STEP 3

Slide the shelf onto the two tubes on the bracket. Ensure the holes on the shelf face downward (refer to Diagram 3A). Secure the shelf to the bracket using the two countersunk head screws from underneath. Avoid over-tightening (see Diagram 3B).

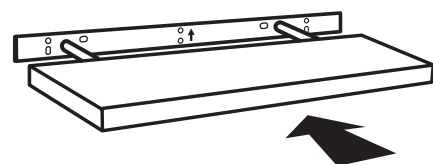
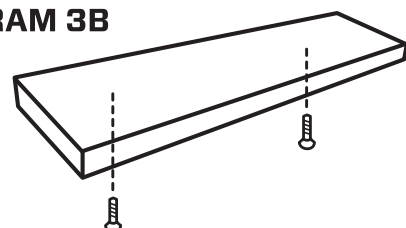

NOTE:

For safety, the bracket pipes are slightly angled upwards to prevent the shelf from sagging under full load. Please be aware that Floating Shelves are designed for displaying infrequently used decorative items only.
